Description of Class: 'Floral Painted Applique' on Silk

You will have a choice between three different flowers for your project. To make it easy, all materials you will need will be provided with just a little homework before class. In addition to painting your beautiful flower, I will also demonstrate how I create my highly textural confetti backgrounds and my technique for turning the edges of the finished applique' for a clean finish. So lets have some fun and create with paint and fiber.
